Position Summary

Street Hope TN is hiring a full-time Prevention Coordinator whose role will be overseeing Street Hope TN's prevention programs throughout Tennessee. This includes coordinating, presenting and implementing our current prevention programming (i.e. Project POST Curriculum, Internet Safety and DMST Trainings, etc.), as well as strategic development and implementation of new prevention programming.
