Street Hope TN is hiring a Prevention Educator, whose role will be to present all trainings under our Prevention Education department. This individual will be a capable communicator who is able to cultivate relationships with local school districts and effectively teach students and adults about the risks associated with trafficking and exploitation.

Principle Duties

Core Responsibilities

- Must embrace Street Hope TN's mission and core values
- Must have experience with and excel at public speaking
- Assist the Director of Prevention Education with current and ongoing initiatives
- Represent Street Hope TN at awareness events where Street Hope TN is involved

Prevention Education

- Enthusiastic about teaching and equipping students
- Present all trainings: Internet Safety for Adults, Internet Safety for Students, Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking (DMST) Awareness, Project POST (Positive Online Social Tools) school education, etc.
- Exhibit a thorough understanding of subject-matter related to training material, especially current social media applications, devices and video games
- Cultivate and maintain relationships with Project POST partners and contacts
- Incorporate new statistics, news stories and pertinent data into trainings as needed
- Clearly communicate how to report potential trafficking to partners/school/staff
- Must be able to work flexible hours, including some nights and weekends (expect to present trainings at least once night a week)
- Willing/able to travel (this position will require travel to surrounding counties)

- Administer student surveys as needed
- Assist in the development of current and new curriculum
